***Lord Loomba** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have to respond to the United Nations' International Widows' Day, specifically with regard to measures to empower widows and their dependants to achieve economic independence. [I]

***Baroness Anelay of St Johns** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the security and humanitarian situation in Sudan; and the adequacy of international assistance to those who have sought refuge in neighbouring countries.

***Baroness Bakewell of Hardington Mandeville** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have, if any, to improve the standards of farm animal welfare.

***Lord Harries of Pentregarth** to ask His Majesty's Government what steps they are taking in co-operation with international partners to reach a global agreement on the regulation of advanced forms of artificial intelligence.
