*Oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Lord Foster of Bath** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have, if any, to address the number of fires caused by lithium-ion batteries in e-scooters and e-bikes.

\***Lord Dubs** to ask His Majesty's Government how many people since January have (1) crossed the Channel irregularly by boat, and (2) claimed asylum having done so; and how many of these asylum claims are awaiting a decision.

\***Baroness Kennedy of Cradley** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the possibilities of emerging technologies to create new opportunities for people who are deafblind.

†\***Baroness Hayman of Ullock** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of (1) the availability of animal torture videos on the internet, and (2) whether existing legislation is sufficient to punish people in the United Kingdom who are involved in the creation or promotion of such content.
