***Baroness Jones of Whitchurch** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the extent to which Drax biomass power station has complied with sustainability requirements; and whether they are reviewing subsidies to it.

***Lord Walney** to ask His Majesty's Government what steps they will take to ensure the United Kingdom meets the increased demands to produce nuclear submarines entailed by the AUKUS agreement with the United States of America and Australia.

***Baroness Deech** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the balance between (1) the duty of local authorities under section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular traffic and pedestrians, and (2) the imposition of low traffic neighbourhoods and low emission zones.

***Lord Clement-Jones** to ask His Majesty's Government what progress has been made in implementing the recommendations on cybersecurity made by Sir Patrick Vallance in his report *Pro-innovation Regulation of Technologies Review: Digital Technologies*, published in March.
