Oral questions (40 minutes)

***Lord Naseby** to ask His Majesty's Government whether they have plans to review the effect on public services of civil servants working from home.

***Earl Russell** to ask His Majesty's Government whether they have plans to increase the number of locally available and easily accessible green spaces.

***Lord Brooke of Alverthorpe** to ask His Majesty's Government whether they have plans to require re-formulation of children's food and drink to reduce child obesity.

***Baroness Falkner of Margravine** to ask His Majesty's Government, following reporting by *The Sunday Times* on 28 January, what assessment they have made of admission policies for foreign students at Russell Group Universities.

Lord Bragg to move that this House takes note of the contribution of the arts to the economy and to society. (3 hours)

Lord Addington to ask His Majesty's Government how they plan to mitigate the safety risks of reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete in schools and to ensure the swift deployment of financial assistance for necessary maintenance and construction upgrades. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Lord Watson of Wyre Forest to move that this House takes note of the case for a comprehensive Industrial Strategy for the United Kingdom. (2 hours)
