\***Baroness Merron** to ask His Majesty's Government what progress has been made on plans to increase the number of medical student places in England.

\***Baroness Jones of Moulsecoomb** to ask His Majesty's Government whether they are taking steps to ban the import and sale of fur.

\***Baroness Anelay of St Johns** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have to mark International Mother Earth Day, and to fulfil the United Kingdom's commitments set out in their White Paper on International Development, published in November 2023 (CP 975).

\***Lord Browne of Ladyton** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the United Nations Special Rapporteur report on *Paying polluters: the catastrophic consequences of investor-State dispute settlement for climate and environment action and human rights*, published on 13 July 2023.
