*Oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Lord Watson of Invergowrie** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the finding of the Sutton Trust's *School Funding and Pupil Premium 2024* survey published on 19 April, particularly with regard to special educational needs.

\***Baroness Ritchie of Downpatrick** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the national immunisation programme, and the steps that will be taken to accelerate the delivery of new vaccines on the programme.

\***Lord Hogan-Howe** to ask His Majesty's Government whether they plan to require pedal cyclists to have insurance.

\***Lord Young of Cookham** to ask His Majesty's Government what representations they have made to diplomatic missions in London on the non-payment of the Congestion Charge.

†*The Lord Privy Seal (Lord True) intends to move the following two motions en bloc: but if any Lord objects the motions must be moved separately.*

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Lord True) to move that Standing Orders 38 (*Arrangement of the order paper*), 40 (*Postponement and advancement of business*), 44 (*No two stages of a bill to be taken on one day*), and 73 (*affirmative instruments*) be suspended until the end of the Session so far as is necessary to allow His Majesty's Government to arrange business.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Lord True) to move that Standing Order 47 (*Amendments on third reading*) be dispensed with in relation to the Victims and Prisoners Bill.

†**Product Safety and Metrology etc. (Amendment) Regulations 2024** Lord Offord of Garvel to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 15 April be approved. *23rd Report from the Secondary Legislation Scrutiny Committee. Considered in Grand Committee on 20 May*

†**Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill** Consideration of Commons Amendments [Lord Offord of Garvel] *Northern Ireland Legislative Consent sought*

†*If the first Business of the House motion in the name of the Lord Privy Seal is agreed it is expected that Committee stage and remaining stages of the Post Office (Horizon System) Offences Bill will be taken.*

†**Victims and Prisoners Bill** Third Reading [Lord Bellamy] *Scottish Legislative Consent granted, Welsh Legislative Consent granted in part*
