***Baroness Winterton of Doncaster** to ask His Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to increase voter registration and participation.

***Lord Davies of Brixton** to ask His Majesty's Government what preparations they are making to inform people born on or after 6 April 1960 about the increase in their state pension age from 66 to 67 which will be implemented over the period 6 April 2026 to 5 April 2028.

***Lord Dubs** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the effectiveness of the BBC World Service.

***The Lord Bishop of Gloucester** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of the prisoner early release scheme on probation services.

Lord Frost to move that this House takes note of the cost of renewable energy and its effect on energy costs in the United Kingdom. (*Balloted debate, 2 hours*) [1]
