***Baroness Ritchie of Downpatrick** to ask His Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure a UK-wide approach to improving outcomes for older people with cancer.

***Baroness Keeley** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have to develop a National Carers Strategy.

***Lord Rennard** to ask His Majesty's Government how they intend to monitor access to continuous glucose monitors for people with type 2 diabetes; and how such monitoring will take account of any inequalities based on deprivation and ethnicity.

***Lord Austin of Dudley** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the police's recording of non-criminal hate incidents.

†**Insurance Distribution (Regulated Activities and Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2024** Baroness Jones of Whitchurch to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 24 October be approved. *Considered in Grand Committee on 18 November*
