House of Lords (Hereditary Peers) Bill Second Reading [Baroness Smith of Basildon]

If the bill is read a second time, Baroness Smith of Basildon to move that the bill be committed to a Committee of the Whole House.

Oral questions, 40 minutes (at 3pm)

***Lord Alton of Liverpool** to ask His Majesty's Government how many individuals have been prescribed anti-depressants by the NHS in England in the past 10 years, at what cost, and what assessment they have made of the risks and ramifications.

***Lord Addington** to ask His Majesty's Government how they will ensure state-funded schools are better able to identify those with special educational needs and better able to meet those needs.

***Lord Rooker** to ask His Majesty's Government, further to the answer by Baroness Merron on 11 September (HL Deb col 1562), whether it remains their intention to lay regulations before Parliament to amend the Bread and Flour Regulations 1998 in 2024.

***Lord Sikka** to ask His Majesty's Government what logistical and supply chain barriers they have identified to the possibility of building 1.5 million new homes by 2029.

It is expected that the debate on the second reading of the House of Lords (Hereditary Peers) Bill will continue.
