***Baroness Benjamin** to ask His Majesty's Government what progress has been made with the Windrush Compensation Scheme in settling unpaid claims.

***Baroness Pidgeon** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have to revise legislation around the use of e-scooters and e-bikes.

***Lord Altrincham** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of the increase in National Insurance contributions for employers on gross domestic product growth.

***The Lord Bishop of Guildford** to ask His Majesty's Government whether they plan to review the rules on home schooling in the light of the murder of Sara Sharif.

The Lord Bishop of St Albans to move that this House takes note of the importance of growing the rural economy. (*Balloted debate, 2½ hours*)

Lord Alton of Liverpool to move that this House takes note of government policy towards China especially in relation to human rights and security issues arising from China's actions in Hong Kong, Taiwan, Tibet, and the South China Sea, and against the Uyghurs in Xinjiang.
