***Baroness Keeley** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the value to state school pupils of school visits to theatres, museums and galleries, and of the value of a creative education for all pupils.

***Baroness Hazarika** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have to tackle court backlogs, and whether they have considered reducing trial by jury.

***Lord Hain** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the prospects for the current peace talks involving Israeli and Palestinian leaders.
